

Solution Elements Include:

- **Monitoring Dashboard:** Log in to a web-based interface to view all monitoring and reporting data
- **E-Mail Monitoring:** Monitor e-mail messages sent and received from the child's mobile device
- **SMS/MMS:** View all transmitted and received SMS and MMS text messages
- **Location Tracking:** Easily locate and track the child and their device
- **Picture Monitoring:** View photos taken, sent and received by the device
- **Automated Alerts:** Parents are proactively notified via e-mail of inappropriate content or communication
- **Voice Communication:** Check call logs of all voice conversations conducted by the device
- **Anti-Theft:** From the dashboard, issue commands to remotely lock, wipe, or backup the device
- **Communication Control:** Block voice and SMS communication from unwanted sources
- **Application Monitoring:** view all third party applications currently installed on the child's mobile device
- **Contacts:** Gain insight into exactly who your child is communicating
- **Anti-Malware and Anti-Spam protection:** Protection from Spyware, Viruses, Trojans and Worms
